What are the Cambridge Technicals Level 3 Qualifications?

Cambridge Technicals are vocational qualifications that are designed to give you a work-focused alternative to A-levels. They've been designed to give you opportunities to demonstrate and develop the practical application of Music knowledge and understanding in the areas of Music performance styles that appeal to you.

This will enable you to develop your based research skills as you work, both independently and with colleagues, to progress through your Music qualifications.

Assessment for the Music qualifications are mainly task-based, meaning it is not heavily exam-focused. However, some units do include exams, which form part of the overall assessment.

They are nationally recognised and equate to the same amount of UCAS points to A-levels. This qualification offers a wide choice of Music units from Singing Technique to Instrumental Music Technique to Songwriting which reflect the range of opportunities available within the performing arts sector. The course provides students with an understanding of performing arts through engagement with Music techniques, the work of Music practitioners, industry conventions and community projects.
