What are the Cambridge Technicals Level 3 Qualifications?

Cambridge Technicals are vocational qualifications that are designed to give you a work-focused alternative to A-levels. They've been designed to give you opportunities to demonstrate and develop the practical application of Theatre Production knowledge and understanding in the areas of theatre performance styles that appeal to you.

This will enable you to develop your text-based research skills as you work, both independently and with colleagues, to progress through your Theatre Production qualifications.

Assessment for the Theatre Production qualifications are mainly task-based, meaning it is not heavily exam-focused. However, some units do include exams, which form part of the overall assessment. The course provides students with an understanding of performing arts through engagement with Musical Theatre techniques, the work of Musical Theatre practitioners, industry conventions and community projects.

They are nationally recognised and equate to the same amount of UCAS points to A-levels. This qualification offers a wide choice of Theatre Production units from Theatre Directing to Combined Arts to Production and Stage Management which reflect the range of opportunities available within the performing arts sector.
