

# Psychology

This course is an A Level Course.

**MINIMUM SUBJECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS** (in addition to the general 6<sup>TH</sup> form minimum entry requirements of 5 x grade 4 at GCSE/equivalent or above including maths and English):

Grade 5 in a Science, Maths and English or other essay-based subject.

In this course you can expect to study topics including: memory, biopsychology, social influence, forensic psychology and relationships. These topics are investigated from a biological, psychological and learning point of view. You will also study the nature of science, other aspects of how psychologists conduct research and the statistical analysis of research findings.

Paper 1: Introductory Topics in Psychology (33.3%), 2 hours, combination of questions: Multiple choice, short answer and extended writing.

Paper 2: Psychology in Context (33.3%), 2 hours, combination of questions.

Paper 3: Issues and Options in Psychology (33.3%), 2 hours, combination of questions.
