

APPENDIX C – Learning Platforms: data items & retention (summary)

Below is a summary of the typical telemetry/learning data and retention. (Where a supplier's default is **shorter**, their default applies.)

Platform	Typical data items	Retention (max)	Notes
Century	login ID, class, assignment/nugget IDs, open/submit timestamps, time-on-task (calculated), scores	12–15 months	Used for adaptive learning; teachers view engagement in context.
Seneca	login ID, course/assignment IDs, attempt timestamps, duration (calculated), scores	12–15 months	Homework/revision analytics are contextual only.
Sparx	login ID, task IDs, completion timestamps, attempts, duration (calculated), scores	12–15 months	Duration not used in isolation to judge effort.
Kerboodle / Pearson Revise	login ID, resource IDs, access timestamps, completion, scores	Up to 15 months	Primarily resource access/submission tracking.
Languagenut	login ID, activity IDs, timestamps, duration (calculated), scores	Up to 15 months	For practice and homework tasks.
Exampro (via Wonde)	login ID, assessment IDs, start/submit timestamps, scores	Up to 15 months	Assessment analytics only; no keystroke capture.
