Re: GCSE Results Day and 6th form enrolment

We sincerely hope you are looking forward to your well-earned summer break. We are eagerly anticipating GCSE results day and supporting you with your next steps. For many of you, this will be returning to Holy Trinity 6th form and continuing your seven-year journey with us.

GCSE Results day is Thursday 20th of August.

You will be able to collect your results in person and celebrate your successes with friends and the Year 11 pastoral team at 0900 in the Refectory. The Year 11 pastoral team will be on hand to distribute your certificates and answer any questions you may have. If you have ordered a Yearbook, you will also be able to collect your copy on the day. Following this, you can head directly to the library, where the Sixth Form Team will be available to help you enrol and officially begin your Holy Trinity Sixth Form journey.

If you have not yet applied for Holy Trinity 6th form you can still do so by following this [link](#). This will enable us to set up Bromcom for your start in September.

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What happens if I have changed my mind as to the subjects I want to take?

That will happen to a few people. Wait until you get your results. These blocks give an indication of whether your change of mind will be possible. Tell us about your final decision on GCSE results day.

What happens if my choices don't fit?

If your choices clash, then we look again at the timetable at the end of August to see if there is a way of making the option blocks work for you. This is not something we can guarantee but we have been successful at managing this in the past. Talk to us on results day. We can confirm whether it will be possible by the beginning of term.

In School Enrolment and Support

Teachers and Sixth Form staff will be available to support students with in-person enrolment and to offer guidance on subject choices where needed. If you would like advice or assistance, please come in during the same times allocated for Yearbook collection.

What if I'm not available on enrolment day?

All Year 11 students will receive their results by email at 1100 on Thursday the 20th.

As the enrolment for the sixth form is also online, you can access the system from anywhere. There will also be a face-to-face opportunity to enrol in person for those who have not registered on Applicaa and have met the entry criteria on Wednesday the 2nd of September at 0845 till 0930.

Please do not send anyone to the school on your behalf to enrol you.

Start of Year 12

Wednesday 2nd September is the Year 12 Induction Day. Enrolled students should arrive at 9:45am to meet their tutor on the front tennis courts and prepare for the start of Sixth Form. This half-day induction will finish at 12:15pm. The afternoon will be dedicated to students who are joining our Basketball Programme.

Thursday 3rd September will be when you can complete bridging work for your chosen subjects.

Friday 4th September will be your first full day in Sixth Form. The school day will begin at 8:40am and finish at 15:10 following the normal timetable.
