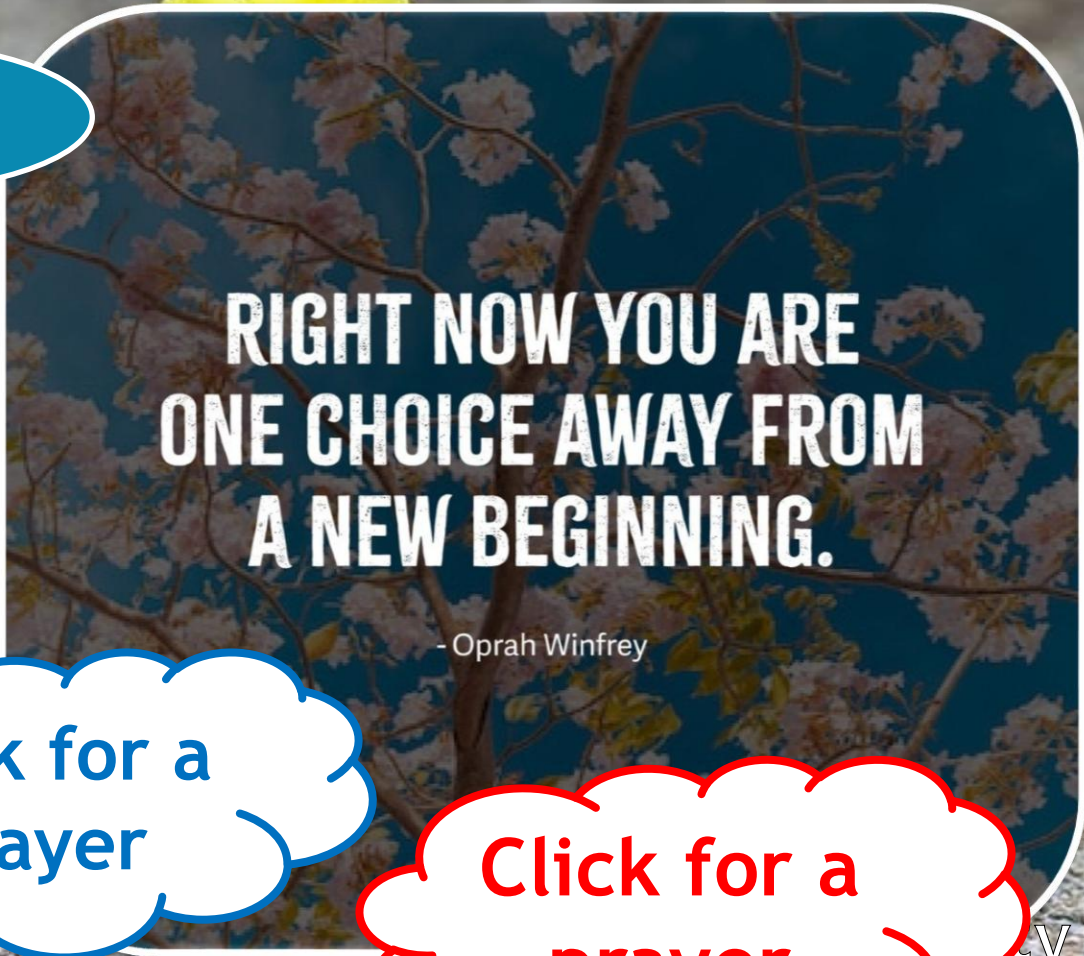

Just a reminder that the book of Proverbs was written by King Solomon. God offered Solomon his hearts desire and Solomon chose wisdom. I wonder how many of us would choose wisdom over a new phone or new clothes? In this verse, Solomon reminds us that our belief in God gives us 'FUTURE HOPE'. In this context, this means an eternal hope; i.e. if we place our hope in God, He will not cut us off and we will live with Him forever.. And ever! ☺

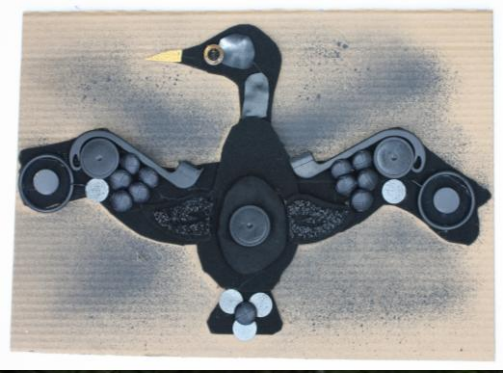
